	Adkhia Darsha / Jyestha Adhik Amavasya 14-15 June, Monday	Jyestha Adhik Amavasya 2026, also known as Adkhia Darsha, marks the no-moon day for ancestral rituals, charity, and spiritual cleansing, bringing peace, protection, and blessings to devotees.
	Nirjala Ekadashi 25 June, Thursday	Nirjala Ekadashi 2026 is the most powerful Ekadashi vrat dedicated to Lord Vishnu, observed without water to gain immense spiritual merit, remove sins, and receive health, prosperity, and blessings.
